## Session 2 Reading: Genesis 1-3; Revelation 5:1-14; 12:7-12; 20:1-15; 22:1-5

- According to Genesis 1:26-28, what was God's job (or ultimate purpose) for the man and woman?
- In Genesis 1:26-28, what does it mean to have "dominion"?
- In Genesis 3:1-6, why did God allow man to be tempted by Satan, i.e. what was the purpose for the temptation? Further, why is he allowed to tempt us today and for what purpose (cf. James 1:1-12)?
- What authority did Satan have when he tempted Eve, i.e. how did he have access to the earth and the garden (cf. Job 1:6-7; 2:1-2; Isa 14:12-17; Ez 28:12-19; John 12:31; 14:30; 2 Cor 4:4; Eph 2:2; 1 Pet 5:8)?
- Genesis 3:15 speaks of a war, with the seed of the woman winning. What does the seed of the woman win (cf. John 16:11; Rev 5:1-7; Rev 12:7-12; Rev 20:1-6)?
